

**Regulations of the Scientific Congress "Central European Congress from Modernization.  
History- Media-Culture" Rzeszów, 23-25.10.2024**

§ 1. General provisions:

1.1. The Scientific Congress "Central European Congress on Modernization. History-Media-Culture", hereafter referred to as the Congress, will be held on 23.10.-25.10.2024 in Rzeszów (or nearby).

1.2. The Conference is organised by the Institute of History of the College of Humanities of the University of Rzeszów.

1.3. The congress is being held as part of the project "Excellent Science - Support for scientific conferences" No. KONF/SP/0129/2023/01

1.4. The following terms used in these Regulations shall be understood to mean:

a. Organised by the Institute of History of the College of Humanities of the University of Rzeszów.

b. Participant: a person whose application sent via the application form available at [www.congressofmodernization2024.com](http://www.congressofmodernization2024.com) will be accepted by the Kogres Scientific Committee.

1.5. The organiser reserves the right to make changes to the programme and the Congress Regulations and undertakes to publish updated information on the website.

1.6. The provisions of these Regulations form an integral part of the Congress Application and apply to all Participants.

§ 2 Participation in the Congress:

2.1. In order to participate in the Congress, it is necessary to register for the Conference by completing the registration form available on the Conference website.

2.2. Registration requires the Participant's personal data, i.e. name, surname, e-mail address, academic degree, institutional affiliation, contact telephone number, form of intended participation, title of the paper, abstract, keywords and consent to the processing of personal data, use of image.

2.3. The Congress participant has the opportunity to:

a. send the finished article in electronic form in doc or docx format to the e-mail address:

[jkinal@ur.edu.pl](mailto:jkinal@ur.edu.pl) until 30.10.2024. The submitted articles will be subjected to the publishing procedure of the relevant editorial office and the author(s) will be informed about the qualification of the paper for publication by e-mail to the previously indicated address. The organisers reserve the right to decide on the qualification of the article for the selected journal and to reject an article that does not meet the publishing requirements.

§ 3 Consent to use of image

3.1. During the Conference, the Organiser may conduct photographic sessions and film the Conference for documentation, promotion and advertising purposes of the Organiser.

3.2. By participating in the Congress, the participant gives his/her free, unlimited in terms of quantity, time and territory, consent to the free use, processing, reproduction and repeated dissemination of the participant's image recorded on the photographs taken during the Congress, without the need for each time's approval, for information, promotional and advertising purposes of the Congress. The above consent is tantamount to the fact that the photographs and recordings taken during the Congress may be posted on the Internet, including above all on the Congress website at [www.congressofmodernization24.pl](http://www.congressofmodernization24.pl) as well as on open, closed and social networking sites Facebook, Instagram, etc.

#### § 4 Personal data:

4.1. The administrator of Participants' personal data is the University of Rzeszów.

4.2. The Congress organiser does not pass on, sell or lend the collected personal data of Participants to other persons or institutions.

4.3. The personal data provided by the Participant is treated as confidential information and is only used for the purpose of communication between the Participant and the Congress Organiser.

4.4. The Participant's personal data contained in the application form collected by the Organiser is processed in order to conduct the Congress in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations, including the creation of the Participant list, badges and the Congress programme.

4.5. By registering, the Participant agrees to the processing of his/her personal data for the purposes of the Congress in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations.

4.6. The Participant's personal data will not be passed on to other data controllers without the Participant's knowledge and consent.

4.7. Provision of personal data is voluntary but necessary for participation in the Congress. Data subjects have the right of access to the content of their personal data and the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability, the right to object, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

4.8. The organiser shall take all appropriate security measures in accordance with the law as well as generally accepted principles to protect the confidentiality of information.

#### § 5 Final provisions:

5.1. The organiser reserves the right to use the e-mail address provided during registration for the Congress to notify Congress Participants of, among other things, changes to the Congress programme and Rules and to send invitations to future editions of the Congress.

5.2. By signing the attendance list on the day of the congress and the registration form, the congress participant confirms that he/she has read the Rules and accepts their provisions.

5.3. By submitting the registration form, the Congress participant confirms his/her consent to the free use of his/her image, voice, statements recorded during the Congress.

5.4. Any disputes that may arise from participation in the Congress will be settled by the court of

competent for the registered office of the Organiser.

5.5. In matters not covered by these Rules, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.

5.6. These Regulations shall enter into force on 01.01.2024.
